

## Melrose Youth Lacrosse “Code of Conduct”

MYLL is implementing a ZERO-Tolerance policy for “unsportsmanlike-conduct.” This applies to ALL coaches, players, parents, and spectators.

In order to participate, all MYLL lacrosse families must sign a pledge agreeing to adhere to the “Code of Conduct” which shall apply to all MYLL events including practices, games, jamborees, tournaments, and banquets.

### “Code of Conduct”

1. Our family will demonstrate respect towards all players, coaches, opponents, officials, and other spectators
2. Our family will demonstrate and encourage good sportsmanship on-and-off-the-field
3. Our family will support a drug, alcohol, and tobacco free environment at all youth lacrosse events
4. Our family will NOT use obscene language (profanity)
5. Our family will NOT engage in verbally abusive language towards players, officials, and coaches
6. Our family will NOT initiate or engage in violent, aggressive, threatening, or physical behavior with others, even if provoked, at any MYLL event.

Violations to the MYLL “Code of Conduct” will be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors. The B.O.D. may administer disciplinary sanctions which can include loss of playing time, expulsion, suspension, and/or the non-refundable removal from the program.

By signing this pledge sheet, I hereby affirm that my family has read, understands, and agrees to abide by the “Code of Conduct.” In addition, we acknowledge and agree to the disciplinary actions the Board of Directors has the right to administer following a violation through commission or omission of the “Code of Conduct.”
